Transportation to Ghost Ranch in Abiquiu and in Santa Fe

If you fly: The nearest major airport is in Albuquerque, 65 miles south of Santa Fe. It is approximately an hour's drive from Albuquerque to Santa Fe and an hour and a half between Santa Fe and Ghost Ranch in Abiquiu. Allow at least two and a half hours travel time between Albuquerque and Ghost Ranch in Abiquiu (not counting connections or waiting time).

If you fly into Albuquerque International Sunport and are going to Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe, make reservation 1 and if you are going to Ghost Ranch in Abiquiu, you must make reservations 1 and 2:

1. From the Albuquerque airport to Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe, and
2. From Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe to Ghost Ranch in Abiquiu.

Reservation 1

Arrival Day (generally Monday) at Albuquerque Sunport — Take a Commercial Shuttle to Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe

Make a roundtrip or one-way reservation on a commercial shuttle service to Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe. Call to schedule and pay for reservations directly. When making your reservation from the Albuquerque airport, plan to arrive at Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe in order to catch the 1:00 p.m. or the 4:00 p.m. Ghost Ranch shuttles in the summer and the 4:00 p.m. shuttle in the spring/fall (see "Reservation 2" below).

Reservation 2

Take Ghost Ranch Shuttle from Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe to Ghost Ranch in Abiquiu

Ghost Ranch provides shuttle service from Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe to Ghost Ranch in Abiquiu on arrival day (Monday afternoon) and from Abiquiu to Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe on departure day (Sunday morning).

Reservation for the Ghost Ranch shuttle is on page 2 of your registration form. Indicate you will be using the shuttle and select the times for departure from Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe on Monday and departure from Ghost Ranch in Abiquiu on Sunday. (We provide round-trip or one-way service.)

Per Person Fee for Shuttle: Round-trip: \$35 One-way: \$20

Cancellation policy: Written notification must be received no later than 30 days prior to the start date of your course in order to receive a refund of your Ghost Ranch Shuttle fee. No refunds will be processed after that time.

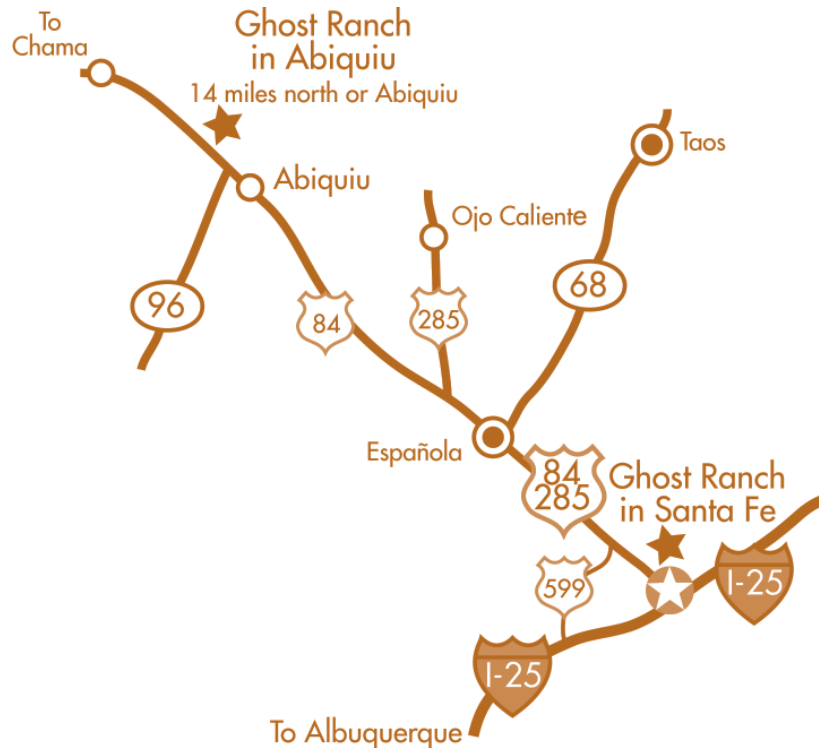

Departure Day: Take Ghost Ranch Shuttle to Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe. Departure from Ghost Ranch in Abiquiu to Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe is at 8:30 a.m. or 10:00 a.m. on Sunday morning in the summer or 8:30 a.m. during the spring/fall (see schedule above).

Take Commercial Shuttle from Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe to Albuquerque airport.

When making your shuttle reservation from Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe, do not make departure plane reservations from the Albuquerque Sunport to your destination before 2:00 p.m. on Sunday.

MAP TO GHOST RANCH IN ABIQUIU & SANTA FE



If you drive: Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe is located 70 miles northeast of Albuquerque off I-25. Once in Santa Fe take the St. Francis Drive exit, turn east onto Paseo de Peralta. Paseo is a horseshoe that intersects St. Francis Drive twice. Going north on St. Francis Drive, turn right at the second Paseo de Peralta intersection. If coming south on St. Francis Drive from the direction of Española, turn left at the first intersection with Paseo de Peralta. Use the Bank of America on the NE corner as a landmark. The Santa Fe site is at the fourth light, on the corner of Old Taos Highway and Paseo de Peralta.

Ghost Ranch in Abiquiu is located 135 miles north of Albuquerque, 65 miles northwest of Santa Fe (35 miles beyond Española) on U.S. 84.

Meal service at Ghost Ranch is not available after 6:30 p.m. Please plan your arrival time with this in mind.

Coming from Albuquerque, take I-25 north towards Santa Fe. You may take the 599 bypass to U.S. 84/285 (this will save approximately 20 minutes of travel) or take the St. Francis Drive exit. St. Francis Drive becomes U.S. 84/285 at the north end of Santa Fe. Once in Española continue through town to the Fairview/Riverside intersection (Walgreen's and the Bank of America are on the corners). Turn left on Fairview to cross the river; then turn right on Paseo de Oñate (U.S. 84). Once on Highway 84, watch for the Ghost Ranch sign between mileposts 224 and 225 (approximately 14 miles north of Bode's Store in Abiquiu).

If you take the train: We advise that you arrive in Santa Fe a day before your course begins due to train schedules (most arrive at 3:00 p.m). When you make your Amtrak train reservation, book through to Santa Fe. Your train ride will end in Lamy and an Amtrak shuttle will take you to Santa Fe. (There is a \$20 charge for the Lamy to Santa Fe shuttle — ask when you make your train reservation.) See "Reservation 2" below for transportation from Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe to Ghost Ranch in Abiquiu.

Everyone coming to Ghost Ranch must be registered in advance by mail only. Call if you have not received confirmation within two weeks from sending your registration form; check your confirmation for accuracy and call the Registrar's Office for corrections.

In order to provide individual attention and opportunity for field trips, class sizes may be limited, so sign up early! Your "early-bird" registration fee will save you \$100 and help us ensure that the course will have enough participants to proceed.

Registration Fee: The appropriate fee is listed below the course name. The non-course participant fee of \$100 is charged for those who are not registering for a course themselves but are accompanying someone who is registering for a course; include any non-course participant family members or friends accompanying those enrolling for a course, all children, and anyone using the campground. The registration fee does not include housing and meals. Payment in full at time of registration is preferred; the minimum dollar amount required is the total of the full registration fee plus a \$300 housing deposit. Payment may be made by check (payable to Ghost Ranch), Visa or MasterCard. Your cancelled check or your credit card statement is your receipt.

How to Register: Please fill out the registration form as completely as possible using one form for each person registering for a course; include any non-course participant family members or friends accompanying those enrolling for a course, all children and anyone using the campground.

Cancellation & Transfer Policy: Written notification must be received no later than 30 days prior to the start date of your course in order to receive a refund, less a \$50 processing charge. No refunds will be processed after that time. We reserve the right to announce a change in leadership or cancel any program 30 days prior to the first day of the course. In that unlikely event, you may transfer to another course without charge or we will refund the full course payment. If you decide to transfer from one course to another, there will be a \$25 fee per transfer, per person.

Course Dates & Class Hours: The first and last dates listed are considered travel days. Generally, arrival day is Monday and departure day is Sunday, with some exceptions. Most classes have morning (9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.) and evening (7:00 p.m. – 8:30 p.m.) sessions, with afternoons free. Some courses may offer optional afternoon studio time, or an occasional field trip. These are noted in the course description. Afternoon child care is not provided.

Pastoral Continuing Education Credit: At your request, a letter can be processed for you as proof of successful completion of your Ghost Ranch course for a \$15 fee. Contact the Ranch at ext. 121.

Scholarship: Ghost Ranch is blessed with many individuals who contribute funds so that financial assistance is available towards a portion of your class registration fee. Scholarships are given (but not limited) to clergy persons, first-time visitors and our neighbors in northern New Mexico. For a scholarship form, please contact the Registrar's Office.



Summer Early Bird Special

Save \$100 on Summer courses by registering before May 15th for courses beginning June 15th and after.

Fall Early Bird Special

Save \$100 on Fall courses by registering before before August 15th for courses beginning September 14th and after.

Housing/Meal Information

Housing and meal costs are in addition to registration fees unless otherwise noted. Anyone coming earlier or staying over on Sunday needs to make special arrangements and pay the per person, per day rate to stay in their room. If a participant is staying for a second full course week, there is no additional charge for the Sunday night stay. Please contact the registrar for more information.

We observe the honor system at Ghost Ranch – there are no locks on guest room doors, and no phones, televisions, alarm clocks or radios in the rooms. Maid service and porter service are not available.

Rooms are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis, with priority given to those with handicap accessibility requirements. The Ranch has a very limited number of rooms with handicap accessibility. Register early if you need this type of room. Bed linens and towels are furnished. Single occupancy rooms may not be available during peak course weeks. For other months of the year single occupancy rooms may be available for an additional \$360 for the week on a space available basis.

There are several styles of accommodations to fit your needs. Most rooms are double occupancy with a dorm-style bath (bathrooms and showers are down an outside porch); some of the dorm-style rooms can accommodate families or groups up to five people.

There are a limited number of rooms with attached (private) or shared (semi-private) baths. Please note that any housing up on the Mesa level involves a short hike up and down a moderately steep trail to the Dining Hall and most meeting rooms.

Camping: Campsites, with or without electricity, and sites for RV's are available in the campground. Rates are for the 6 days/nights of the course week. Meal tickets may be purchased in the Main Office; meals in the Dining Hall will not be served to campers without a ticket. Reservations for specific campsites are not accepted. Campers who are registered for a Ghost Ranch course should check in at the Main Office, and then with the Campground Host. The bathhouse is equipped with an ice machine, showers, sinks and coin-operated laundry. There is a 10-20 minute walk to the Dining Hall and meeting rooms. Most campsites are provided with picnic tables and fire rings. Campfires are permitted only when weather conditions allow. No pets allowed in the campground, please.

Housing & Meals Fee: The costs shown include housing for 6 nights and all meals for 6 days for one person. Meals begin with dinner on the first evening of your course (generally Monday) through breakfast on the last morning (generally Sunday). No refunds are made for missed meals or voluntary early departure.

Meals: Non-vegetarian and vegetarian entrees plus a salad bar are offered at lunch and dinner each day. Meals are served cafeteria style with choice of indoor or outdoor dining. The Food Services staff will make every attempt to meet your special dietary needs; please list them on your registration form. However, extremely restricted diets may be problematic; those on such diets may want to consider bringing some supplementary foods.

Check-in Information: The first and last dates of your course are travel dates. Check-in will begin after 2 p.m. on the first stated date of your course, generally on Monday (early arrivals must make arrangements with the Registrar's Office), with dinner at 5:30 p.m., followed by a Ghost Ranch orientation. Individual classes will meet briefly thereafter. The week ends with an 8:30 a.m. Sunday worship service during summer weeks. Check-out time from your room is 10 a.m. on the last stated date of your course (generally Sunday).

Housing Rates for Abiquiu

Housing prices listed below are for all guests who are enrolled in Ghost Ranch courses, except where noted. Rooms are typical rustic, no-frills ranch housing, with bed linens and towels provided. Most rooms are double occupancy with a *dorm-style bath* (bathrooms and showers are down an outside porch); some of the dorm-style rooms can accommodate families or groups up to five people. There are a limited number of rooms with *attached* (private) *baths* or *shared* (semi-private) *baths*.

Lower level housing refers to accommodations that are located on the main level of the conference center grounds. **Mesa housing** is located on a small hill and involves a short hike up and down a moderately steep switchback trail to the main campus level, the Dining Hall, and most meeting rooms. **Mesa suites** include a living room that contains a sleeper sofa. The lower level offers a variety of dorm-style baths, attached baths, and shared baths, while Mesa housing offers only dorm-style baths and attached baths. Note: Having a private bath does not mean having a private room; one may have a room with a private bath and still be assigned a roommate.

Regular Rate: For groups of two adults without children, single participants who will be assigned or designate a roommate, or one adult traveling with a child or children, adults pay per person fee below, and children accompanying adults pay according to the following schedule. These prices include meals.

Adult (11 years and older):	full price
Child (4 – 10 years of age):	half price
Infants/Toddlers (3 and under):	no charge

Family Rate: When groups of three or more stay together in one room, the first two adults pay the full per person fee, but others pay only for their meals at the following rates:

Other Helpful Information

Health: Ghost Ranch is committed to accommodating all individuals who wish to participate in its programs and be part of the community at the Ranch. Located in the high desert at an altitude of 6500 feet, Ghost Ranch is very remote from medical facilities. The nearest hospital is 35 miles away, and the Ranch provides only basic first aid services. The Abiquiu Clinic is 15 miles away but has limited hours and services. There is a 5–15 minute walk from most rooms to the Dining Hall, library, museums and meeting rooms. **We strongly urge people with health challenges to consult with their physician before registering.** Remember to bring a sufficient supply of medications for the week.

Weather: The high desert altitude (6500 feet) can produce extremely variable weather. Winter and spring temperatures can range from lows of zero or below at night to highs of 70° at midday; be prepared for rain and/or snow. Summer temperatures range from 50° to 95°, with afternoon thunderstorms possible.

What to Bring: To make your stay more comfortable you may want to pack the following:

*comfortable, casual clothes you can layer * sturdy walking shoes * rain gear * hat * flashlight * sun block * toiletries * alarm clock * hair dryer * bathrobe * small box of laundry detergent * small portable fan for room (summer) * cash for vending machines and Cantina purchases. There is no on-site ATM machine available.

Computers & Telecommunications: Due to Ghost Ranch's remote location, cell phones may not work. Some phones are available for guest use; make long-distance calls with a phone card (available at the Trading Post). Some wireless hot spots (for cell phones and laptops) may be found at various places on the Ranch. Computers with Internet access are available in the computer lab. Children in the computer lab should be accompanied by an adult.

Persons with Disabilities: Children and adults with disabilities are welcomed at Ghost Ranch. Please contact the Registrar's Office to discuss the type of accommodations you may need. This includes, but is not limited to, wheelchair accessible bedrooms, special diets and hearing equipment. *A limited number of golf carts are available for use by persons with special needs. Priority will be given to those demonstrating proof of need via a handicapped sticker or doctor's note. Cost per week is noted on the registration form. A valid driver's license is required and a golf cart policy agreement must be signed. Please call ext. 152 for golf cart needs.* Please note all of your special needs on the registration form. If you use a wheelchair or scooter and need shuttle service from the Albuquerque airport to Ghost Ranch in Abiquiu, call ext. 152.

Pet Policy: No pets are allowed on the Abiquiu campus, including the campground, with the exception of assistance animals with prior notification to the Registrar's Office. Please call Black Mesa Kennels at 505.753.9530 for information about boarding pets.
