

New Directions for Ghost Ranch Santa Fe
July 21, 2010

The Governing Board of Ghost Ranch is committed to launching a new direction in programming in Santa Fe with a focus on significantly increasing enrollment and closely linking programs to spiritual formation and personal transformation, in coordination with the mission priorities of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). The initial focus will include the areas of Spirituality and the Arts, the Emerging Church, and Sustainability and Creation Care. Some of the more viable current programs will be retained.

The Governing Board has recognized the extreme limitations of the current physical site on Old Taos Highway that have significantly limited our mission in Santa Fe and the reality of a history of operational deficits that will no longer be funded by PC (U.S.A.). In response, the Board is exploring closer coordination with local partners in Santa Fe including churches, colleges, museums and lodging facilities, to place programs at facilities that better serve the needs of the Ranch and its program participants, creating a distinct Santa Fe presence for Ghost Ranch. The Governing Board is exploring the options of lease and/or sale of the current Old Taos Highway site, with recommendations to the General Assembly Mission Council of PC (U.S.A.).

The Governing Board welcomes the participation and passion of so many who care deeply about the continuation of mission and ministry of Ghost Ranch in Santa Fe. Representatives of the Board will be meeting with critical constituencies over the next months to answer questions or concerns.
