Instructors/Retreat Guides

John Philip Newell, the celebrated author of *Listening for the Heartbeat of God: A Celtic Spirituality*, is one of the most prominent Christian teachers of spirituality in the Western world. His PhD is from the University of Edinburgh and he has authored over 15 books, including *Praying with the Earth* and his most recent visionary title *The Rebirthing of God: Christianity's Struggle for New Beginnings*. In 2016 he founded the School of Celtic Consciousness in the belief that Celtic wisdom is needed at this moment in time, urgently.

Cami Twilling is the Director of Contemplative Spirituality at Trinity United Methodist Church in downtown Denver, Colorado. A retreat leader and certified Spiritual Director, she has been leading mountain, urban, international and local retreats for more than 20 years in addition to weekly meditation and prayer practices. She also serves on the leadership team for the School for Celtic Consciousness in Colorado where she collaborates with John Philip Newell in the teaching and spiritual practice of the School.
