Welcome to “Creating Beauty in the Kiln with Fused Glass” at Ghost Ranch.

What will we cover?

This class is for all skill levels. Experienced glass fusers will find plenty of techniques and supplies to try something new. New glass fusers will learn to cut, grind and design fused glass masterpieces. Because of limited kiln space and time for firing, we will be working on small jewelry and ornament size projects (4”x4” maximum.) We will cut and grind fusible glass and add design elements then high temperature fire to slump, fuse, and finish the glass. We will be using COE 96 compatible glass in sheet, frit, powder, stringer, dichroic and specialty glasses.

What will be available?

Ghost Ranch has all the basic tools, glass, findings and all of the consumable supplies that you will need to make multiple projects during the week. Your registration fee includes \$10 worth of glass and findings per day. Additional findings, premium glass, advanced projects and supplies to continue your glass fusing at home will be available for purchase from the instructor. A favorite project are nightlights, the light kit with bulb is \$5.00.

What to bring?

Closed toe shoes are required at all times in the studio. If you have favorite glass cutting tools, please bring them. Bring a water bottle. Also come with ideas and a willingness to create and have fun.

What will the class schedule be?
