Supply List:

Please feel free to bring any supplies you want to use or that you may want to show others how to use while at Ghost Ranch. I made this list as a basic suggested packing list, and I have added some items that might be new to you that you may be interested in testing.

- A drawing pencil HB (medium soft) or 2B (soft)
- A kneaded eraser
- A small sketch book
- Watercolor Paper and board or watercolor block – whatever size and weight you prefer
- Watercolor Paint whatever brand and colors you prefer
- Watercolor Brushes
- Palette
- A plastic water jar
- A small jar of gum Arabic
- A small jar of oxgall
- Masking fluid
- A roll of toilet paper with no added scent or moisturizer
- A roll of drafting tape or art tape (no masking tape, please)
- A pipette, eye dropper or drinking straw
- Anything you think that might be used to make Ghost Ranch textures like an old tooth brush, sea sponges, alcohol, salt etc.
- Carrying case for supplies a light tool or fishing box, cloth bag or back pack
