To make the most of your workshop experience at Ghost Ranch, please bring the following items:

Photography Equipment

- Digital camera (DSLR or mirrorless preferred, but all cameras welcome)
- Tripod (sturdy enough for long exposures and windy conditions)
- Cable shutter release or remote trigger
- Extra memory cards and fully charged batteries
- Laptop computer with image editing software (such as Lightroom, Photoshop, or equivalent) I also use and recommend Nik Silver Efex software for converting my images to B&W.
- Power cords, chargers, and any necessary adapters

Personal Supplies

- Refillable water bottle (there are several filling stations available)
- Light snacks and sufficient water for half-day hikes
- Comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing
- Sturdy shoes or hiking boots suitable for uneven terrain
- Sun protection (hat, sunscreen, sunglasses)
- Bug repellent
- Small backpack for carrying gear and personal items in the field

Bringing these essentials will help ensure that you are prepared for both the creative and practical aspects of our time together. Being comfortable in the environment allows you to fully focus on learning, creating, and enjoying the art of black and white photography.
