

Supply List

Watercolor I at Ghost Ranch

A drawing pencil – HB (medium soft) or 2B (soft)

A kneaded eraser

Paper – Two 9" x 12" Strathmore cold press watercolor paper pads with 12 sheets each (series #300, 140 lb.)

Board - One 11" x 14" hardboard panel - available at Blick's (dickblick.com) or you can use a piece of plywood or Plexiglas large enough to tape your 9" x 12" paper on to.

Watercolor Paint – Please buy one small 5 ml tube each of the following student grade Winsor & Newton Cotman brand watercolor paint. It is important that all students have these same tubes of paint:

- Lemon yellow
- French ultramarine blue
- Alizarin crimson

Brushes- 1 inch wide flat watercolor brush for washes

- 2 smaller flat brushes varying in size

- 2 or 3 round brushes varying in size

- An old tooth brush or a stencil brush

Make sure you buy watercolor brushes and not acrylic or oil brushes, and please no sable brushes

Palette – You will need a water color palette (they come in plastic or metal). It is always a good idea to have extra jar tops, saucers or Tupperware lids for extra puddle mixing.

A plastic water jar

A roll of toilet paper with no added scent or moisturizer

A roll of tan or white drafting tape or art tape (no masking tape, or blue tape please)

A pipette or eye dropper

Carrying case for supplies - a light tool or fishing box, cloth bag or back pack
