### What To Bring?

1. Curiosity with an open heart and mind.
2. Warm clothes! (Thermals, wool socks, warm hat, jacket, gloves, etc.) Nights out under the stars should be clear, crisp and chilly. While we may not be out all night, temperatures drop significantly after sunset. Plan to keep warm! Please keep in mind that ideal weather conditions are never guaranteed but class sessions will be given regardless of any adverse weather.
3. Binoculars if you have them.
