All levels of weaving experience are welcome! I will demonstrate the entire process from selecting color and design to using a warping board, dressing the loom, weaving, and then finishing your towels so they will be ready to use. Even with years of weaving experience, I always learn something new, and hope you will too.

You will choose your design of stripes and plaid (from patterns provided or from your imagination), choose your colors from a palette of 8 desert colors (some clear like the sun and the turquoise, some neutral like the sand and the rock), and choose your "weave structure" (either plain weave or twill). Everyone's towels will be unique!
